Failure to do so may result in a civil action for breach of trust.
- Claims: All breakages or shortages must be notified to the carriers and to ourselves on the day of delivery. Non-delivery of goods must be reported to us within 10 days of the date of the invoice. No claims can be met unless these conditions are fulfilled.
- Availability: Wines are offered subject to remaining unsold. All prices are subject to market and duty fluctuations
